Oak Island...

The fabled treasure of Oak Island is an enduring tail. I first came across this in a magazine series that my father used to subscribe to in the early 80's. Back then, if you liked a subscription, you had to get the Newsagent to order it for you and then collect it from the shop. Our Neighbourhood had two little grocery shops back then which also operated as News outlets. Corner shops were a sort of everything shop. Nevertheless, the series was call "Unexplained". It covered all sorts of unexplained phenomena. A few that still stand out are, 'spontaneous human combustion' (which is nonsense), 'Bigfoot', (to which I remain very sceptical: could be possible) and the mystery of 'Oak Island'.

This story was really interesting to me because it conjured up all sorts of possibilities. Oak Island is an Island just off Nova Scotia and upon it there lies the prospect of hidden treasure. Since the 1700's, people have been searching there for treasure, possibly from Captain Kidd or one such Pirate. Upon the Island, there is one such spot called 'The Money Pit', which has been the focus of this ongoing quest. No one has ever found anything, but the quest continues. Six people have lost their lives so far searching for this illusive treasure, to no avail. Up until this point, more than fifty books have been written about it, there have also been documentaries and numerous articles. At the time, I first read about it, I was very much into the Goonies, which was all about finding the secret treasure of the fabled pirate, one-eyed-Willie. Pirates were very much in vogue for young lads then.

As I look back on the story it has a different meaning for me today and is a kind of warning. The stories are a bit like a metaphor, like the story of the Sirens calling people to wreck their lives on the rocks. But what is it that makes such stories so dangerous? I believe it is the way in which the mystery encourages us to lay down our guard because of the enticement it offers. We get a high out of such stories, which makes us more intoxicated with it's supposed truth. Yet, in the end, it is in truth a red herring, a false trail and, for some, a disastrous endeavour. We all love a story, but we should always be willing to admit, that at the end of every quest isn't a rainbow, or at the end of every pursuit, hidden treasure. Some things are just stories and nothing more.

PARISH COUNCIL UPDATES



The Parish Council met on Tuesday 9th September. There were ten councillors present and eleven members of the public. Our Herefordshire Council Ward Councillor, Mrs Pauline Crocket was in attendance. Our Clerk, Mrs Paulette Scholes ensures that meeting are conducted effectively.

After welcoming those present and receiving apologies, we always start with the most important part of the meeting. We firstly get an update from Cllr Crockett about Herefordshire Council's activities that might affect the Parish. We then open the floor to local residents who can raise issues of interest or concern. We always listen carefully to these and do our best to respond including agreeing to consider issues at future meetings.

Issues raised included; traffic management, tree planting on Tillington Common and a ditch crossing to access Tillington Common. These issues will be discussed at our next meeting.

Traffic management including speeding is clearly a concern. As a Parish Council we don't have any direct ability to implement or enforce speed limits, or for road signs / markings. We can only try to work with Herefordshire Council who manage our local roads. We have recently had some success with extending 30mph limits and the new arrangements by the school. We now have two Speed Indicator Devices that rotate around the Parish. Following recent accidents on the Tillington Road we have asked Herefordshire Council to monitor vehicle speeds and we hope that this will lead to further initiatives.

There are usually a number of Planning Applications to be considered. These are always determined by Herefordshire Council but we are consulted and respond reflecting local views and our Neighbourhood Development Plan which is our guide to local planning policies. Our responses are always recorded in our minutes which are available as a draft on the Parish Council's website as soon as possible after a meeting.

Other matters discussed included a new drainage grant from Herefordshire Council, whether we can update our Neighbourhood Development Plan given that it's likely that the Parish will have to accommodate around 70 new homes by 2041 and the new Charter for Herefordshire's Councils which promotes partnership working between the Parish / Town Councils and Herefordshire Council. The Charter is managed by a new Herefordshire-wide Reference Group which represents all the county's local authorities. Our Vice Chair has been elected to Chair this Group.

Our next meeting is 11th November, 7.00pm. Please do come along and observe or make a contribution. We currently have a vacancy on the Parish Council, if you are interested in joining us and helping to make a difference locally, then please do contact our Clerk (details on our website).



Bird Resistant Ornamental Berries and Fruits

Although it is good to plant fruiting and berrying plants which will feed our local wildlife, it is also rather pleasing for the gardener to be able to enjoy the sight of ornamental fruits and berries which will persist a little longer into winter. Here are some suggestions:

Red berries and fruits are normally regarded as the most tasty and attractive colour by wildlife and tend to get gobbled up first. However, the clustered red crab apples of Malus 'Red Sentinel' are hard and waxy, and can often last on the tree well into the New Year, eventually succumbing to frost damage and bio degrading.

Another persistent red is the scarlet berried low evergreen Gaultheria procumbens which makes a great winter basket or tub feature, as do young plants of Skimmia reevsiana with their very hard red berries.

The clustered berries of some types of 'Mountain Ash' (Sorbus aucuparia types) can feed the birds if you grow the red and yellow forms, yet other types with white or pink berries often remain untouched (e.g. Sorbus hupehensis, 'Pink Pergoda' or Vilmorinii), decorating the bare branches of the winter tree on pink stems long after the leaves have disappeared.

Generally white berries are much less attractive to birds so the white fruits of the Snowberries (Symphoricarpos) – as well as its pinky-violet berried forms – will also persist. So too will the blue flushed, white berries of some of the coloured stem dogwoods (Cornus alba types.)

For a real steely blue, the bird resistant berries of a pollinated female plant of Viburnum davidii are difficult to beat and can often still be seen the following spring. You will need both a male form and a female form together to get a good show of berries on the female shrub.

Another distinctive and eye catching shrub is Callicarpa 'Profusion' which bears clusters of small berries of bright violet colour on pollinated female plants. A personal berrying favourite of mine worth mentioning (even though, alas, one whose berries will not persist uneaten into Christmas) are the profuse clusters of red flushed, creamy-yellow berries of the prickly Berberis wilsonii, complemented by its lovely autumn leaf colour. These fleshy berries are very underrated yet are an autumn joy to behold.




If you visit the village shop you will notice that the nearby cross road grass area is always kept very short and tidy- it helps motorists and even pedestrians to enter the main road safely.




